Foothills Nordic Ski Club Refund Policy

(Effective September 8, 2020)

- 1. Foothills Nordic Ski Club memberships are non-refundable.
- 2. A \$50 administration fee will apply to **ALL** program refunds. A \$35 administration fee will be charged for program or session changes.
- 3. All requests for program withdrawal must be submitted in writing (email is an acceptable form) to the relevant Director; either the Cross Country Program Director or the Biathlon Director.
- 4. When a program withdrawal request is accompanied by a letter from a medical professional, refunds for medical reasons are available for all programs. The amount of the medical refund is prorated on a monthly basis.
- 5. For programs that begin in May (a.k.a. 11-month programs):
 - a. If the request to withdraw from a program is received prior to October 1, the amount of the refund is prorated on a monthly basis.
 - b. No refunds will apply to withdrawals after September 30.
- 6. For all other programs:
 - a. If the request to withdraw from a program is received at least 30 days prior to the start of the program, the program fee will be refunded.
 - b. If the request to withdraw from a program is received no more than 14 days following the start of the program, a refund equal to 50% of the program fee will be provided.
 - c. No refunds will apply to withdrawals after 15 days following the start of the program.
- 7. In the event that in-person programming is cancelled due to circumstances outside of the control of FNSC, the club will pay a prorated refund of the program fee to all affected registrants in any of the following programs: Bunnies, Jackrabbits, Marmots, Teen Ski, Jackrabbit and Adult Learn to Ski, Track Attack, Biathlon Bears, and Racing Bears.
- 8. This refund policy applies to program and membership fees only. It does NOT apply to trips, camps or events.

2020-2021 Season COVID-specific Cancellation Policy

For Bunnies, Jackrabbits, Marmots, Teen Ski, Learn to Ski, Biathlon Bears, Track Attack and Racing Bears: In the event that more than 50% of the in-person programming sessions are cancelled due to circumstances outside of the control of FNSC, members who are registered in the affected programs may request, in writing, a refund of 50% of their membership fees and a prorated refund of trail fees.
